God created everything out of nothing in the beginning. God creates order out of chaos, but we tend toward sin which makes chaos in the world. Jesus is telling us that as the end approaches there will be chaos: powerful earthquakes, famines, and plagues, but worse yet "they will seize and persecute you... you will even be handed over by parents, brothers, relatives, and friends, and they will put some of you to death." Now does that sound like a well-ordered creation? It sounds like chaos. Human beings being unfaithful leads to chaos in the world, but do not be afraid because, "by your perseverance you will secure your lives." The first reading from Malachi prophesies, "Lo, the day is coming blazing like an oven when all the proud and all evildoers will become stubble... but for you who fear my name, there will arise the sun of justice with its healing rays." There it is again: sin will lead to our destruction and chaos, but the gift of fear of the Lord will bring healing. Fear of the Lord is trained. It is not a natural fear like fear when we meet a dangerous animal on a path. The kind of fear God wants is a wonder and awe of him and a fear that we will ever find ourselves on the wrong side of God because of our pride and evil doing.
