“Thus says the Lord: ‘You shall not molest or oppress an alien,
for you were once aliens yourselves in the land of Egypt’
(Exodus 22:20). We hear this in the first reading this week and
it fits rather well into October which is “Respect Life Month.”
We respect life all along the continuum of life from the womb
to the tomb because God whom we love created this life. We
support those who are vulnerable because Jesus calls us to love the Lord
and our neighbor. “Jesus said to them, ‘You shall love the Lord, your God,
with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the
greatest and the first commandment. The second is like it: You shall love
your neighbor as yourself’ (Matthew 22:37-39). The US bishops wrote
earlier this month: “Love Your neighbor: join the share the journey
campaign.” The bishops continue, “Pope Francis is calling us and we are
responding. This month the Holy Father launched **Share the Journey** – a
global campaign to increase understanding of our neighbors who have fled
their homes seeking shelter and safety.” “Let mutual love continue. Do not
neglect hospitality, for through it some have unknowingly entertained
angels.” (Hebrews 13:1-2). It goes a step further in Matthew 25 when we
welcome God in the stranger. “Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the
Universe” takes the part of a stranger. Jesus says, “For I was... a stranger
and you welcomed me” (Matthew 25:35).
