The good shepherd lays down his life for his sheep. In baptism we are anointed to be like our savior because Jesus is the Christ or the Anointed One. The priest, deacon, or bishop says when he anoints the child after baptism, "God the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ has freed you from sin, given you a new birth by water and the Holy Spirit, and welcomed you into his holy people. He now anoints you with the chrism of salvation. As Christ was anointed Priest, Prophet, and King, so may you live always as members of his body, sharing everlasting life." Bishop Folda, during his confirmation homily, has talked more than once that we can see "Christ" in our name, Christian. We are anointed to be part of his Body and part of that role is leadership, or being a king or shepherd. When difficulties come along, true followers of Jesus will not run away leaving the wolves to scatter the sheep. As fortified, courageous members of his body, we defend the weak and protect the needy. St. Augustine says that we cannot take the role of the Good Shepherd if we have not first been good sheep, followers of Christ. We pray for the Gifts poured out upon us in Confirmation to be developed. May courage or fortitude be ours when we have to stand up for His sheep.
